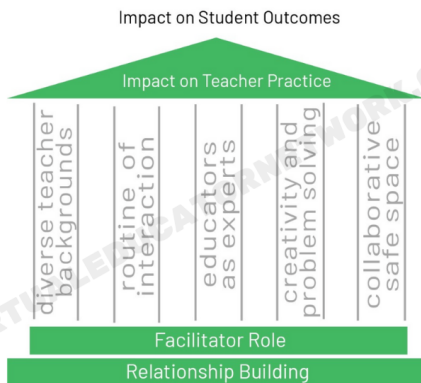


KEY COMPONENTS OF THE VEN:

The Pantheon visual shows the different components that create the VEN.

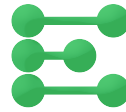
Key Components of the Virtual Educator Network

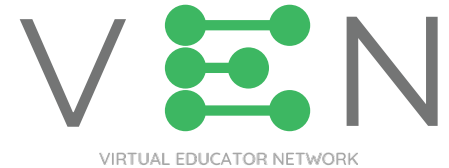

- **VEN Certified Trainer (VCT)** - Train new facilitators. Includes 30 hours of training, CEUs (for Social Workers), and a 2-year certification.
- **Option 4:** The VEN Founders will work with you to create a customized plan to meet your organization's needs.

How it works: Participants enroll in a course of six online sessions. A trained facilitator guides the group of practitioners through receiving and offering advice, sharing strategies and recommendations from fellow practitioners, and providing support to each other.
